



Public Notice Regarding IPARD II requirements related to National Farm Register for Measure 1 and Measure 7.

Due to a Conceptual Error in the drafting of the GFA (Guideline for Applicants), a non-proper information was given in regard to the IPARD II Program requirements under Measure 1 and Measure 7.

The IPARD II program requires all Recipients to be: “Farmers, whether natural persons or legal entities, including co-operatives, registered in the National Registration Centre **and included in the national farm register.**”

In the Guideline for Applicants such information was not properly transmitted since the National Farm Register is not fully complete.

A false information was given stating that applicants can provide Farmer’s NIPT for the purpose of the above criteria.

In order to respect the IPARD Program requirements, the sound financial management of the program and to ensure continuation of processing for the application regarding Measure 1 and Measure 7:

All applicants affected, that have presented Farmer’s NIPT only will be asked to provide a Certification from the AREB Offices stating their farming activity and farm registration.

The request will be send via mail individually and will also include all other missing documents arising from the regular evaluation of the application.

15 calendar days, from the day of receiving of the Notice will be given to present all missing documents as well as the AREB Certificate.

ARDA Agency has taken all necessary steps to ensure absolute priority from the AREB offices for the process and full availability to ensure all Certificates are issued upon request of the applicant in due time.
